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1 Important information

1.1 Note on Using this Document

2.2 Emissions

The Flow gripper SCGS emits noise due to the operation of compressed air.

2.3 Intended Use

The Flow gripper SCGS has integrated vacuum generation for gripping and transporting objects in conjunction with suction pads. It is particularly well suited to applications that require a high suction flow rate.

Neutral gases are approved as evacuation media. Neutral gases include air, nitrogen and inert gases (e.g. argon, xenon and neon). For further information, see (> See ch. Technical Data).

The product is intended for industrial use.

Any other use is considered improper by the manufacturer and is deemed as contrary to the designated use.

2.4 Non-Intended Use

Schmalz accepts no liability for damages caused by non-intended usage of the product. In particular, the following are considered non-intended use:

- Use in potentially explosive atmospheres
- Use in medical applications
- Lifting people or animals
- Evacuation of objects that are in danger of imploding

2.5 Modifications to the Product

Schmalz assumes no liability for consequences of modifications over which it has no control:

- 1. The product must be operated only in its original condition as delivered.
- 2. Use only original spare parts from Schmalz.
- 3. The product must be operated only in perfect condition.

3 Product description

3.1 Application Description


The Flow gripper SCGS has integrated vacuum generation and is used to grip and handle non-rigid and unstable workpieces. It is generally suitable for all applications that require a high suction flow rate. It is particularly suitable for gripping all porous materials, such as foams, textiles, paper, plastic films, composite textiles and the like.


Compressed air must be connected to the appropriate interfaces in order to operate the Flow gripper SCGS, i.e. to generate the vacuum and blow off.

The Flow gripper SCGS does not contain any moving parts, which makes it low maintenance and less susceptible to faults. It may be installed in any position. The blow-off function allows you to deposit the gripped workpiece actively and with high precision.

A variety of different suction pads can be connected.



5 Checking the Delivery

The scope of delivery can be found in the order confirmation. The weights and dimensions are listed in the delivery notes.

- 1. Compare the entire delivery with the supplied delivery notes to make sure nothing is missing.
- 2. Damage caused by defective packaging or in transit must be reported immediately to the carrier and J. Schmalz GmbH.

6 Installation

6.1 Installation Instructions



▲ CAUTION

Compressed air or vacuum in direct contact with the eye

Severe eye injury

- Wear eye protection
- > Do not look into compressed air openings
- > Do not look into vacuum openings, e.g. suction cups



▲ CAUTION

Noise pollution due to incorrect installation of the pressure and vacuum connections Hearing damage

- Correct installation.
- Wear ear protectors.

Take note of the following when mounting:

- Dirt particles or foreign bodies in the gripper connections, hoses or pipelines can lead to partial or complete gripper malfunction.
- Shorten the hoses and pipelines as much as possible.
- Insufficient compressed air is supplied if the internal diameter on the compressed air side is too small. This prevents the gripper from performing as specified in its defined performance data.
- Protect the flow gripper SCGS from vibrations and shocks.
- Hose lines must be laid without bends or crimps.
- Connection symbols and designations are located on the gripper. These must be observed.

6.2 Mechanical Attachment

Use only the connections, mounting holes and attachment materials that have been provided.

The flow gripper may be installed in any position.

The flow gripper SCGS can be adapted to your handling system using the thread integrated in the holder.

1. Use the G4 female thread of size G¹/₄" to mechanically fasten the SCGS.


2. Use the G1 male thread of size M20x1 (interface 6) to mount suction areas and suction pads or customer-specific grippers.

6.3 Connecting Compressed Air

The compressed air connection (inlet) for supplying the integrated vacuum generation is labeled with the number 1, as shown in the figure.





 Connect the compressed air for the "suction" function to the G1/8" thread labeled with the number 1. The compressed air connection (inlet) for supplying the blow-off function is labeled with the number 12, as shown in the figure.



 Connect the compressed air for the "blow-off" function to the M5 thread labeled with the number 12.

7 Control





Vacuum is generated by the activation of the "suction" compressed air connection (1). The object to be handled can then be gripped and transported.

The "blow-off" compressed air connection (12) can be activated to deposit the object quickly. No compressed air may be present at the "suction" connection (1) for this to occur.

8 Cleaning the Flow Gripper

- 1. For cleaning, do not use aggressive cleaning agents such as industrial alcohol, white spirit or thinners. Only use cleaning agents with pH 7–12.
- 2. Remove dirt on the exterior of the device with a soft cloth and soap suds at a maximum temperature of 60° C. Make sure that the silencer is not soaked in soapy water.

Maintenance work may only be carried out by qualified personnel.
